- 1. Permission to construct may be denied where the proposed owner(s) is/are not a citizen(s) of Barbados or permanent resident(s) of Barbados within the meaning of the Immigration Act.
- 2. Whereas permission has been granted to construct, authority to proceed may be denied for any of the following reasons:
 - a. Where construct is in progress and it is the opinion of the inspector or other qualified / authorised offices that on completion of work, the vessel may not be considered sea worthy and safe for fishing.
 - b. Where the owner(s) fails to agree to, or comply with any prescribed standards as may be set out in writing by the Chief Fisheries Officer.
 - c. Authority may also be suspended on the recommendation of an inspector or other qualified / authorised person, until such time as the Chief Fisheries Officer is satisfied that all concerns are appropriately addressed.
